Beginning Chinese	This is an entry-level course in Mandarin for students with little or no prior experience in the language. The course was designed with standard-based curriculum through immersion environment. Simplified Chinese characters will be introduced and practiced. The emphasis will place on standard pronunciation, vocabulary and simple sentences; and basic speaking (conversations) and listening according different backgrounds. Intermediate Chinese	Intermediate Level I: Comprehensive intermediate level course will cover listening, speaking, reading, and writing of the language. This course will prepare the student to use the language in a variety of everyday situations, discuss topics with accurate pronunciation, and improve reading and writing skills. Upon completion of this course the student should be able to read and comprehend a 200-character article in 5 minutes and write a 500-character article in Chinese. Intermediate Level II: Comprehensive intermediate level course covering listening, speaking, reading and writing. This course will prepare the student to use the language in a variety of everyday situations, discuss topics with accurate Chinese, as well as improve reading and writing techniques. Upon completion of this course the student should be able to read and comprehend a 400-character articles in 5 minutes and write an 800 character essay in Chinese. Advanced Chinese	This comprehensive advanced level course will train the student to confidently carry on discussions covering an extensive range of topics with accurate Chinese, to read a variety of authentic source material including newspapers, magazines, and novels and to write 1000 - 1500-character articles in Chinese. AP/SAT Chinese	AP/SAT Chinese level is about intermediate-high to advanced-med. This course will help students to prepare their AP/SAT exam by applying the interpersonal, interpretive, and presentational modes of communication in real-life situations as they study major concepts in six thematic units, family and community, personal and public identity, beauty and aesthetics, science and technology, contemporary life, and global challenges. Business Chinese	Any economic and commercial transaction between China and foreign country may be viewed as cross-cultural activities in nature. The removal of language barriers and difficulties that lie in the understanding of the culture, subtle points and principles expressed by a target language will be greatly beneficial for one's commercial success. This course is designed to teach business Chinese in three- in- one training pattern that combines the language as a carrier with commercial activities and cross-cultural knowledge with a focus on vocabulary and conversation for the business professional. Students will increase Chinese proficiency in the areas of international business, economics, trade and finance. Students will explore both language and cultural aspects of doing business in China. Course for Teacher	Two college level courses for foreign language teachers: 1. Methods of Teaching Foreign Languages 2. Teaching Special Students in Regular Classroom The purpose of the teacher institute is to provide training sessions for teachers of Chinese to assist them in curriculum development, strategies and daily lesson plans using STARTALK six principles and TELL. Student-Centered Classroom Instruction, Stay on Target Language, Performance-Based Assessment with Backward Design will be emphasized. Teachers will learn the standards for teaching foreign language which include the Five C's: Communication, Cultures, Connections, Comparisons, and Communities, and modes of communication. They will practice developing and writing learning lesson and unit plans using backward design, performance objectives presented using the target language. Teachers will be given an opportunity to present a daily micro-lesson to demonstrate their understanding of the concepts just learned. These will be immediately assessed, using a checklist, by their peers and instructional staff. During the third week of instruction participants will be observing in the children's classrooms, presenting a unit to real children which they have designed. They will be given opportunities to practice these presentations in the teacher classroom. Feedback will be given using the checklist by peers, master teachers and instructional staff. Participants will also receive information on the national and State of Maine requirements for certification.
