The full scholarship allows you to:

- Enroll in an undergraduate, master or doctoral degree program
- Study in any field of your choice
- Apply to some of the top universities in China
- Receive a monthly stipend
- Receive medical insurance coverage
- Experience a rich and diverse culture

Scholarship Coverage

- Tuition fees;
- Free university dormitory or accommodation subsidy;
- Stipend:
 - Undergraduates: CNY 2,500 per month
 - Master's students/general scholars: CNY 3,000 per month
 - Doctoral students/senior scholars: CNY 3,500 per month.
- Comprehensive medical insurance:
 - CNY 800 per person per year
 - CNY 400 per person (for programs lasting less than six months)

About the Chinese Government Scholarship

Chinese Government Scholarship Program is established by the Ministry of Education of P.R. China. China Scholarship Council (CSC) carries out the routine management of the Program.

Eligibility

U.S. citizens with good academic performance and good health status both.

Duration of Scholarship

The Chinese Government Scholarship covers both major study and Chinese language (preparatory) study. The language courses last one year, whereas the duration of the scholarship for major study conforms to that as required.

Institutions and Majors

Designated Chinese universities offer scholarship recipients academic programs in science, engineering, agriculture, medicine, economics, law, management, education, history, literature, philosophy, and fine arts, among others. Reasonable Living Expense

Although prices in China are rising, the cost of living there is still favorable compared to most industrialized countries. You can afford a lifestyle you are unlikely to enjoy at home: travel every month, and enjoy frequent restaurant meals, and nights on the town.

Application

- Copy of passport front page with validity past March 1, 2025
- Notarized highest diploma
- Official academic transcripts
- Language qualification certificates (valid HSK reports)
- A Study Plan or Research Proposal
- Two letters of recommendation
- Applicants under the age of 18 should submit the valid documents of their legal guardians in China
- Foreigner Physical Examination Form (To be completed after March 15, 2024)
- Non-criminal record report
- Applicants shall apply to Chinese Consulate-General in New York through dispatching authority, CLCCM.
- Processing fee \$750 to CLCCM if you get the scholarship.
- **Deadline: January 2, 2024**
